

Eagle Scout Project for The Road Home

Thank you for wanting to complete an Eagle Project to benefit The Road Home! Below is information on starting and delivering your project, as well as project ideas. Please contact Ashley Farmer, Volunteer Coordinator, at 359.4142, ext. 648 or afarmer@theroadhome.org with any questions or for more information about your project.

Once you decide on a project, you will need an approval signature for your handbook. Please contact me with your project information and we will set up an appointment. If it is not convenient for you to come to The Road Home for your signature and your council approves it, I am happy to mail an approval letter. Please send an email to: afarmer@theroadhome.org outlining your project and include your address along with your city and zip or call me directly at 359.4142, ext. 648. Remember to include your project information.

Once you have completed your project, notify me via email or phone. The best times to deliver your items are between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m., Monday – Friday. The Road Home is located at 210 South Rio Grande (455 West). Donation instructions are posted on the side of the building and the gate. Pull up to our gate and honk; once it opens drive back to the loading dock. We have staff that will help unload your donations. If a weekend day is more convenient, we will gladly accept your project on Saturday or Sunday; before 3:00 p.m. is best. Please note I am here Monday-Friday, usually in the afternoons.

You will need a final signature in your handbook from The Road Home to show your project has been completed. Due to the nature of my schedule, I may not be available when it's convenient for you to deliver your project. In that case, either someone from the Development Team, warehouse staff or the front desk staff can provide a signature. Please make sure you have contacted me regarding your completed project.

Miscellaneous:

Toilet paper

Paper cups

Paper plates

Garbage bags (40gallon heavy duty)

Pad locks with keys
