

Hi all!

I want to provide some information about a major COVID-19 testing initiative at the Men's Resource Center in South Salt Lake and the Midvale Family Resource Center, both run by The Road Home.

All clients at the Men's Resource center, who are currently asymptomatic, are being tested for COVID-19. The testing at the Men's Resource Center, which began yesterday, is a follow up to two positive COVID-19 tests last week for men who had stayed at that location.

This morning at the Midvale Family Resource Center, teams conducted thorough screenings of all family members and did testing as needed.

Partners include the Resource Center operator, The Road Home, along with medical team support from the State of Utah, Salt Lake County Health Department and Medical Reserve Corps, Fourth Street Clinic, the University of Utah Wellness Bus, and Intermountain Healthcare.

As results come back from this testing, individuals who tested positive will be taken to a Salt Lake County facility to recover in isolation.

The Road Home will continue to work in partnership with the county and conduct daily screening to ensure that anyone showing symptoms in the days ahead are identified and will be connected to testing in a timely manner.

Planning is continuing and testing will happen as needed at the other Resource Centers.
