HOW IT WORKS

Your group can help us make sack lunches for the children staying with us. The lunches are made off-site (does not need to be in a commercial kitchen), and then brought in by 11 AM for our staff to distribute.

Lunches will be distributed to the pre-school age children first and then to the older children as they get back from school. Because the kids come back from school and after school programs at different times, we do not know how long we will need to store the lunches. This is the reason why we ask for a sandwich that does not need to be heated or refrigerated.
