THE ROAD HOME

The mission of The Road Home is to help local people overcome homelessness and move back into our community.

History

Originally established in 1923 to assist stranded travelers, The Road Home has grown to address a spectrum of needs encountered by people experiencing homelessness including: emergency assistance, shelter, case management and housing services. Emergency Shelter services include the SL Community Shelter and Resource Center, and the Midvale Family Center, which are open 365 days a year, including holidays, to help meet the needs of single men, women, and families in our community. In addition, The Road Home has developed a comprehensive housing program with case managers focused on helping people find and maintain housing as quickly as possible.

Highlights July 1, 2016—June 30, 2017

- In partnership with Salt Lake County, the Road Home Launched the Pay for Success—Housing Not Jail Pilot Program. This program helps single individuals who are persistently homeless stabilize in housing.
- Implemented a Trauma Informed Care approach.
- Transformed crisis service delivery to include Shelter Diversion. This program helps people experiencing homelessness to find alternatives to entering into shelter.
- Operation Rio Grand improved public safety by reducing crime and created a safer community, while also increasing access to treatment for substance use disorders.

Goals for the coming year:

- Provide Trauma Informed services throughout the agency
- Partner with Shelter the Homeless and Cowboy Partners in the development of the Magnolia—a new housing location for people experiencing chronic homelessness.
- Help our community transform our homeless resource center service delivery systems.

We are sincerely grateful to each of you for making it possible for people to receive the refuge, resources, and relief they need to overcome homelessness!
